Song ideas for your ceremony

- Ambient music to set the tone – played while your guests arrive
- Prelude Songs – played just prior to the beginning of the ceremony
- Processional Songs – played as the wedding party and important guests are seated
- Bride Entrance Songs – as the Bride walks down the aisle
- Interlude Songs – during the lighting of unity candle or other special ceremonial event, could be special music intended for reflection, perhaps used while bride and groom thank their parents one on one right after the exchanging of the rings, transition songs
- Recessional Songs – played to mark the conclusion of the ceremony, as the couple and wedding party leave
- Postlude – played as all other guests are leaving the wedding, either heading to the receiving line. Even if you are planning on having a receiving line at the reception, it is suggested that at least the bride, groom, and parents form to thank people for coming after the ceremony.
